1.1.1 Installation Overview

Installation Overview

General Installation Instructions

Follow the provided instructions to install the Antero program. The installation instructions cover installations for computers used to store and serve data to other workstations or clients, stand-alone machines and client/workstation computers.

Installation Guide:

At the server/for stand-alone machines:

- Install MS SQL Server
- Install Antero Client
- Run Application
- Select License Option
- Create a new database
- Select Database
- Establish user security

At the clients/workstations:

- Install Antero Client
- Run Application
- Select License location
- Select Database


Installation Instructions

1. Run the Antero install by running the Setup_Antero_6.15.0171.exe file located on the USB drive or from the file location if downloaded from the web.

Note: Installation instructions can be viewed at any time by clicking the hyperlink located in the lower left hand corner of the windows.

NOTE: OPC Core Components Redistributable (x86) 101.2 is required and included on this installation media. If necessary, the installation for this will be performed automatically.


- The next window will display information about the status of required software before the installation can continue. For more information about the required software, click any of the items. Once all requirements are met, click **Next** to continue.



- Please read the End User License Agreement and select "I accept the agreement". Click **Next**.




4. If a previous version of Antero is found (V5 or newer), the installation process will remove the previous installation before continuing. Click **Next**.




5. Select the Destination Folder where the application will be installed. To change the destination folder, click **Browse...** Click **Next** to continue.

NOTE: Suggested path: C:\Program Files (x86)\AllMax Software\Antero\



6. Select any additional tasks and click **Next**.



7. Click **Install** to begin the installation.

8. Upon completion of the installation, click **Finish**.

 - Recommended: Windows 10, Server 2016
- Microsoft SQL Server

Microsoft SQL Database Support

Microsoft® SQL is the database support used for Antero and is required to be installed on the server or serving computer (this includes stand-alone machines).

The installation of the Microsoft SQL database support requires the following settings for Antero to function properly:

- An existing installation of the Microsoft SQL Server program, the following versions are supported:
 - Microsoft SQL Server 2008
 - Microsoft SQL Server 2008 R2
 - Microsoft SQL Server 2012
 - Microsoft SQL Server 2014

- Microsoft SQL Server 2016
- An existing instance of the Microsoft SQL database.
- An ability to configure the port setting in the Microsoft SQL database instances to communicate on port 1433.

Upgrades

Follow these instructions to setup, install and apply program update to existing installation of the Antero program. Updates are normally provided through a web download.

1. Navigate to the AllMax Software Client Area at (<https://www.allmaxsoftware.com/client-login.aspx>).
2. Enter your license number and zip code in the boxes provided and click **Login** button.
3. Navigate to the Software Downloads and Updates section and select the **View Downloads** button.
4. Select the latest version of your software and select the **Download** link.
5. The download progress will be displayed at the bottom of the screen. When it is finished downloading click the file at the bottom of the screen and when prompted; select **Run** to start the installation process.
6. The database may need to be updated to the latest version. A prompt will be provided when the Antero program is opened. Follow the prompts provided to complete.
7. Updates will need to be applied to all computers using the Antero program.




1.1.2 Initial Setup

Initial Setup

When the application is started for the first time and no license is found, an initial setup window will be presented with three options.




- **Create a 30-day evaluation license** - Use this option to create a 30-day evaluation license and sample database on the local computer.
- **Create a new license (I have a keycode)** - Use this option if you have purchased a license from AllMax and want to create a license database.



- **I already have a license on another computer** - Use this option if this computer will connect to a license database on a different computer/server.

Note: If a license has been created on a different computer, select that computer from the list.
