1 Welcome to Operator10 Water

Operator10 Water[®] is a full-featured data management application designed to help meet the data collection and reporting needs for the Water and Wastewater Treatment industries. Operator10 Water allows users to manage data that has been manually entered, calculated (via internal formula or user-defined formula) or collected from an alternate data source, such as LIMS, SCADA, data import and/or DataPort.

Unique Location: Parameter data points provide the means by which data is stored and shown throughout the application. Unlimited Location: Parameters can be created to define regulatory reporting data, process control data and other internal data points.

DataViews, custom defined collections of Location:Parameter data, serve as tools to enter and review available data. The Charts section allows users to produce unlimited full-color, 2-dimension and 3-dimension charts capable of displaying raw and summarized data for user-defined multi-day, -month or -year periods. Stock regulatory and custom reports are able to be created and managed for previewing and printing as well as electronic data export.

This help file is designed to help users, new and experienced alike, and provide a valuable reference to the tools and features available in Operator10 Water.

2.1.1 Installation Overview

Installation Overview

This installation guide includes instructions to create a new installation of Operator10 Wastewater or to update an existing installation.

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Before you begin:

• Back up any existing Operator10 databases (for existing installs) Installation:

- Run Operator10 Installer
 - $_{\odot}$ Installer will check for Microsoft .NET and install if it is not found
 - o OPC Core Components Installer will run
 - $_{\odot}$ You will need to read and agree to the EULA
 - Operator10 will install

Initial Setup / First Run:

- Create a License
- Add a Sample or License Database

Important Installation Notes

If you are an existing user of Operator10 Water, it is important that you complete the following steps:

- Prior to installation, perform a backup of all active databases.
- Install version 11.25.0338 (see Installation Guide and Installation Instructions).
- Update prior version database(s).

Installation Instructions

Installation Instructions:

1. Run the Operator10 Water installer by running the setup file located on the CD, USB drive or from the computer location if downloaded from the web.

Note: Installation instructions can be viewed at any time by clicking the hyperlink located in the lower left hand corner of the windows.

Note: Microsoft .NET 4.5.2 is required and included on this installation media. If necessary, the installation for this will be performed automatically.

Note: OPC Core Components Redistributable (x86) 101.2 is required and included on this installation media. If necessary, the installation for this will be performed automatically. These components require Microsoft .NET 1.1 or 2.0 to be installed.

- 2. Click **Next** on the Welcome screen to continue.
- 3. The next window will display information about the status of required software before the installation can continue. For more information about the required software, click any of the items. Once all requirements are met, click **Next** to continue.

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6. Select the Destination Folder where the application will be installed. To change the destination folder, click **Browse...** Click **Next** to continue.

- 9. Upon completion of the installation, click **Finish**.

Updates:

Follow these instructions to setup, install and apply program updates to existing installations of the AllMax operations programs. Updates are normally provided through a web download, for both the Server and Client installation.

- Download the file from the AllMax Software Client Login page (<u>https://www.allmaxsoftware.com/client-login.aspx</u>) to the machine that you wish to apply the update.
- 2. Locate the downloaded update file and run by double-clicking.
- 3. Click **Next** to proceed with the update process or **Cancel** to exit.
- Upon completion and opening the application for the first time, the database may need to be updated to the latest version. Select the database and click the Update Database button. Follow the prompts provided to complete.
- 5. Program updates will need to be applied to all computers using the AllMax programs.

2.1.2 Initial Setup

After installation of the application, additional steps will be required on first run to set up or connect to a license and other items needed to use the application.
